



Standing Voice Terms and Conditions London Landmarks Half Marathon 2018

Guaranteed/Charity place:

For this Challenge, you pledge to raise a minimum of £350 (excluding gift aid) in sponsorship money for Standing Voice which should be received by Standing Voice within one month of the Challenge. All funds raised through the Challenge must be payable to Standing Voice in £ sterling. The objective is to raise as much sponsorship as possible.

All participants:

- You confirm that you are medically fit and that you participate in the event at your own risk. Standing Voice will not be held responsible for injury or illness resulting from your participation.
- You understand that it is your responsibility to read any terms and conditions issued by the race organisers and to comply with these.
- The minimum age for this event is 18 years old. You confirm you will be the minimum age on race day.
- You acknowledge that Standing Voice may incur costs as a result of you joining Team SV (e.g. cost of producing kit) for this challenge. The objective is to raise as much sponsorship as possible.
- Should you, for whatever reason, not take your place, all sponsorship forms and monies collected should be forwarded to Standing Voice or returned to your sponsors.
- You have provided Standing Voice information about you and consent to Standing Voice using this data. You understand that it will be necessary for Standing Voice to share the data with the race organisers in order to participate in this event.
- We will keep your details on our database, so we can provide you with the best possible support every time you contact us.
- You agree for Standing Voice to pass your personal details to the organisers of the London Landmarks Half Marathon (LLHM) in order to fulfil your place in the event. Your details will be used by LLHM in accordance with their own privacy policy.
- All participants, supporters and spectators, including friends and families who choose to attend the event confirm that they are happy for their names, video footage, photographs taken of them during the event to be used to publicise the event by Standing Voice for commercial and fundraising purposes including, but not limited to marketing material, social media, advertising, publications, and other documents or mediums that may be made available to the public. Photographs of children will not be used in this manner without express written consent; unless the images are incidental, for example, children's images at the starting line.
